Description:

This presentation will cover in detail Standard 40, addressing residential wastewater treatment system testing and certification relating to CBOD5 and TSS reduction, and the newly adopted Standard 245 relating to nitrogen reduction. There are many similarities between the two, making it helpful to present them together. We will also address the policy obligations of the manufacturers relating to service and maintenance, and other aspects of certification. And finally, we will discuss any changes that may be under consideration by our expert committee for these standards. In order to better understand the process for developing these American National Standards, we will also provide some background on the consensus building and standards development process.
