

R. S. Applicants:

The Registered Sanitarian Examination will be administered once a month at different sites throughout the year. See attached sheet for current year dates and locations.

Applicants are required to submit a completed application, an **ORIGINAL COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT**, a photocopy of their college diploma and \$30.00 examination fee (\$30.00 fee is paid each time the exam is taken). Applicant must also submit evidence at least and approved four (4) year High School or the equivalent; and has completed a four (4) year degree from a college or university, with a minor or twenty-four (24) semester hours in Environmental Health, Biological Science, or Physical Science.

Applicants wishing to take the exam will provide a picture ID, prior to taking the exam (Day of Exam). They must arrive at least 15 minutes prior to test time to conduct administrative functions. Applicants must register at least ten (10) working days prior to the set of the test date, with the application and fees given to Beverley Joy Watkins or Guy Delius. Applicants will be notified of their test results within fifteen (15) working days of taking the exam. No study materials will be allowed in the test area. The Exam will begin at 9:30 A.M. until 11:30 A.M. – Break for lunch and resume 2nd part at 1:00 P.M. – 3:00 P.M.

The Exam consists of 300 multiple-choice questions. There is a 60% pass rate (**120 questions can be missed**). Recommended study material is the CDC Environmental Health Sciences (SS3010) Study course. Recommended texts are the “Environmental Engineering and Sanitation” and the 1994 supplement by J.A. Salvato, Jr. And “Principles of Food Sanitation” by Norman G. Marriott, Some health departments may already have copies of one or both of these books.

The R. S. Committee has purchased five (5) copies of each of these books (but not the study course) and they are available for loan out. They maybe checked out for up to 60 days. Individuals will be personally responsible for the cost of the materials unless brought back prior to taking the exam. Study materials must be returned to the R. S. Board in Order to be eligible to take the exam.
